Dear Los Angeles Rod & Reel Club Member:


Every year at this time the annual request for dues takes place. It is the start of a very busy time that culminates with the publication of the annual yearbook in February. Keeping track of 180 plus members in 8 different membership classes is daunting work. No one wants to see a mistake in their roster listing, perhaps a misspelled name, or wrong phone number or old email address. However, every year we fail to get responses from individuals, or the responses we get do not update information, especially email or they are illegible, leaving the yearbook committee members to guess the letters and numbers.

Here are the steps to get it right.

1. **PRINT** your name on top of the **Roster Information Form**.
2. Review your information in the 2008 yearbook. Your yearbook entry is included with the **Roster Information Form**.
 - a. If you are a new member not in the yearbook, please **COMPLETE** the entire form.
 - b. If **NO CHANGES** are required, check the appropriate box. Your information for 2009 will be the same as 2008.
 - c. If **CHANGES** are required, make them directly on the yearbook information provided to you.
3. **Complete** the **2009 Membership Dues Form**.
4. Take this opportunity to make a **tax-deductible donation** to the LARRC Foundation.
5. Include your payment by check or credit card. If using a credit card, be sure to include your **account information and signature**.
6. Do all this **NOW** and do not wait for the deadline of November 30, 2008.

A family is defined as a husband, a wife and all minor children of either the husband or wife, up to the age 21 or until married, whichever comes first. Emeritus Membership: Members Emeritus are Active or Family members whom the Board of Directors has elevated to this status because of their long standing dedication and service to the Club.
