
## CAPTAIN DAVE HANSEN

## ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS

◆ **IN CASE YOU MISSED IT...** An article in Western Outdoor News (3/28/19) by outdoor writer James Swan noted that the 2017 US Fish & Wildlife Service reported that the number of fishermen has stabilized. Some states however saw the number of licenses decrease. Among these, California was the worst. Stats for 1982 the number of licenses sold was 2,541,627. In 2018 1,777,008 fishermen bought licenses.

◆ **FOUNDATION NEWS...** A recent visit to the LARRC FDN meeting confirmed that grants to Wild Oceans will be renewed this year. Wild Oceans - originally known as the Coalition for Marine Conservation - has been very active in helping to maintain our fisheries. One of their main goals has been to help maintain the prey base which is the bottom of the food chain for all the major species we like to target. Thank you Joel Steinman and other foundation members.

◆ **KING SALMON SCOOP...** The projected King Salmon Regulations for 2019 (Sitka) from Jan. 1 to June 30 is three fish 28" or more. (Of course there are other species of salmon) For any other type of info go to ADFG Website.

◆ **MODERN FISH ACT...** We reported last month that this act, now signed into law, essentially recognizes the importance of sport fishing. This federal fish act allows management to better control both recreational and for profit fishing. A recent issue of "Tide", published by CCA and very informative for all anglers explains the details.

◆ **SCRIPPS SCIENTISTS GET GRANTS TO STUDY CALIFORNIA COASTLINE...** Four researchers have obtained grants of \$250,000 each to study how climate change is affecting shifting conditions along the Pacific Coast. Spawning and effects of sea level rises will be studied along with genetic identification techniques.

◆ **CURRENT TRADE (TARIFF) DISPUTES WITH CHINA...** The focus of this report, in National Fisherman, cites the 2018 season. Prime effects are cited for the State of Alaska which exports almost a billion \$ worth of seafood to China annually. Some of this seafood is processed in China and reimported to the USA. Will this now face a tariff increases of as much as 25%? Stay tuned.

White Sea Bass is tough fishing-you cast all day and all night. It's cold and wet and you start asking yourself: why am I doing this?


Had dinner on shore-early to bed because I was meeting Brandon at 4:00 the next morning on the pier.


