
# LARRC Forms Committee to Help Save Recreational Fishing

Recent events gave impetus to a meeting which convened February 21st. You will recall that a suit filed in Superior Court of Sacramento was ruled on in favor of the recreational community. It upheld the right to examine the records of the MLPA Blue Ribbon Task Force and the Fish & Game Documents used to arrive at the decisions. It was ruled that these papers should be made available since the entities involved were, after all, state agencies. Additional litigation was filed in January in San Diego asking that the restrictive rulings decided on by the Fish and Game Commission be set aside. By now all know how these decisions were unfairly arrived at.

These actions were initiated by the Partnership for Sustainable Oceans (PSO). PSO is a vast organization composed of recreational and fishing industry interests. It is spearheaded by United Anglers of Southern California.

(UASC) Their fundraising arm is the Ocean Action Protection Fund. (OAPF). All of us know that litigation can be expensive. LARRC has donated \$5000 to this cause and the new committee is dedicated to helping keeping this litigation alive.

## A Most Incredible Trip

A February 5 report from **Bill Roecker**—the “boat meeter” in San Diego and dock reporter for the San Diego Sportfishing Council—features some unusual results.

The best trip of the current big fish season ended when **Randy Toussaint** docked his *Royal Star* at Fisherman's Landing, February 5 after a Braid trip with 21 anglers. The group caught 30 tuna over 200-pounds and two over 300. JP fish was caught by a Phoenix angler on his first trip in seven years. It weighed 338-lbs. and was taken on a sardine spiked on a 7/0 Mustad circle hook.

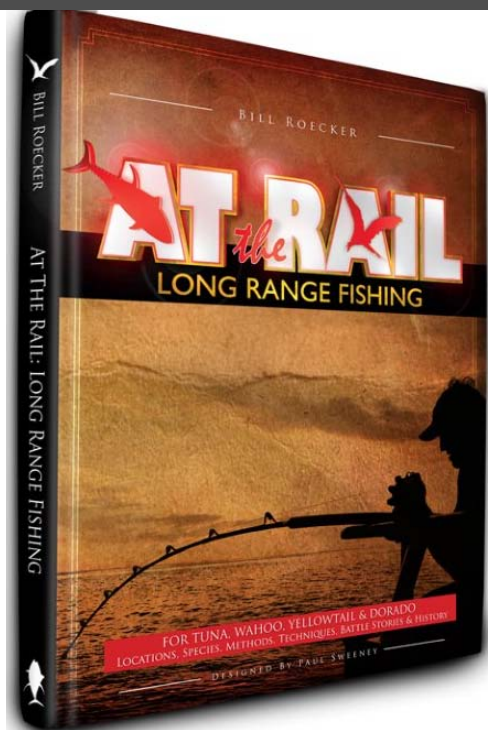
He used a 100-lb. blackwater flourocarbon leader on 100-lb. spectra and a Penn 30W 2/speed modified by Cal Sheets.

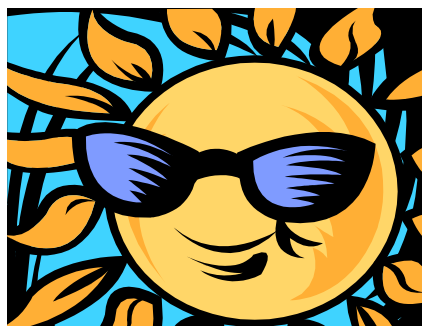

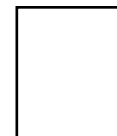
