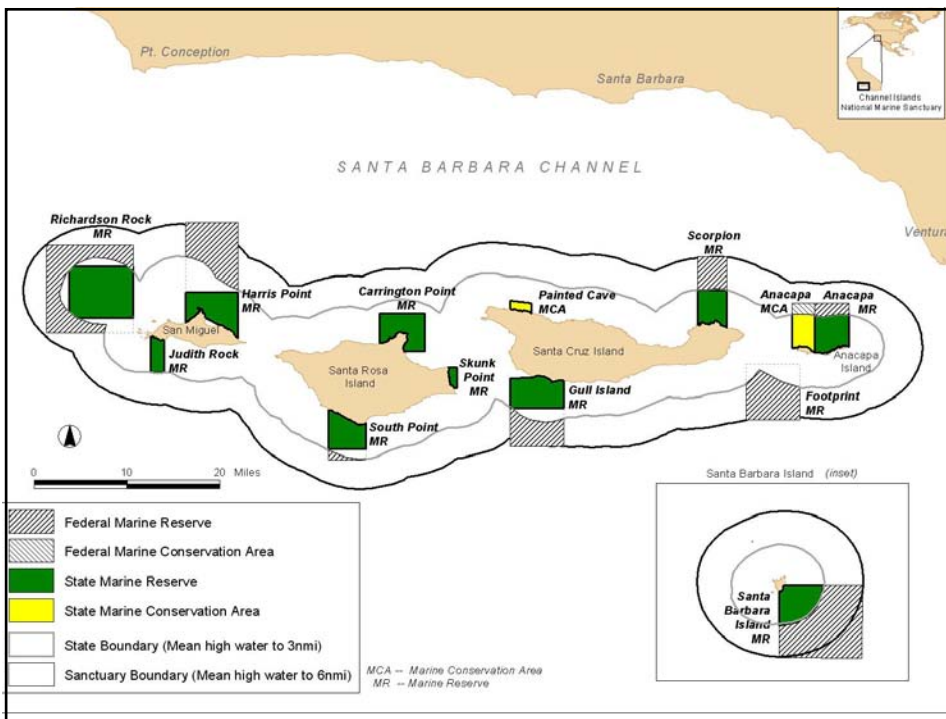

Marine Reserves—There Goes the Neighborhood!



The *Ventura County Star*, in a story dated April 24, reported that the no-fishing areas around the Channel Islands will be doubled in size by fall. It is expected, by NOAA scientists, that the largest network of marine reserves on the West Coast will cause entire ecosystems to flourish in coming decades.

By fall, federal marine reserves will go into place, which when combined with the existing state reserves, will increase the area to a network of 242 square nautical miles of no-fishing

zones around the five island of the Channel Islands National Park. Most of the federal reserves will extend the state reserves from three nautical miles offshore to six nautical miles.

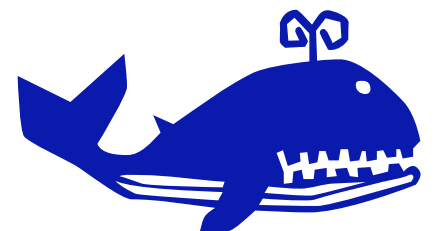

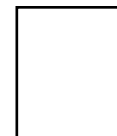
